SpeedLifeSaving Switzerland invites you to probably the fastest race of the Lifesaving Sports history.

The concept of Speedlifesaving is easy. The official ILS Pool Lifesaving disciplines, which are designed for a 50 m Olympic pool will be reduced by 50% and held in a 25 meter pool. In addition, certain performance measures have been removed but the disciplines have to be performed generally compared to the ILS Rulebook. SpeedLifeSaving is the fastest and most powerful variant of a Pool Lifesaving Event.

After the pandemic-related (COVID-19) failure of the last two years, we will try to be there for you again with our competition in 2022. A definitive decision as to whether we can hold the competition can only be made in spring 2022. However, we are confident that this will be possible and looking forward to seeing you again on the probably fastest race of Lifesaving sports in history.

Victory Ceremony	After the dinner.
Note	Each competitor will receive a heat number and a lane at the beginning of the competition in which he/she has to complete the whole competition. For a frictionless competition the competitors are requested to bring all the competition equipment back to the initial position.
Registration	At latest <b>31. March 2022</b> (online) The registration is only possible on <u>LCAS.ch</u>
Changes	Deadline for changes is <b>21. April 2022</b> . (after this date, no more changes are accepted)
Cost regulation	Charge for participation and closing dinner/party is CHF 50 per person (entry fee and dinner). To save bank charges the costs has to be paid by the Team Manager before the competition (accreditation) in cash to the organizer. Drinks at the dinner and the party can be bought for the wholesale price, as cheap as possible. It's not necessary to bring your own drinks.

Absence	In case of absences the costs will be charged to the Team Manager.
Confirmation	Approximately 5 days before the competition the event registration confirmation will be sent with further information.
Closing dinner	The dinner is organized by the competition organizer and is in principle compulsory for all participants.
Travel expenses	Travel expenses have to be paid by the participating delegations themselves.
Starting requirement	<ul> <li>Own competition equipment (fins)!</li> <li>All registration information's must be fully provided.</li> <li>All costs must be paid before the start.</li> <li>All conditions of the competition rules of "SpeedLifeSaving" must be recognized.</li> <li>The Wetiz SpeedLifeSaving Competition Caps must be worn</li> <li>A valid covid certification of 2G+ must be given for each athlet</li> </ul>
Limitation of Participants	For organizational reasons, the number of participants is limited to 120 participants (60 women / 60 men $\rightarrow$ 15 teams).
Legal responsibility	The organizers are <b>not</b> liable for accidents and material damage caused during the event.
Overnight accommodation	We offer an option for accommodation (sports hall) at the venue where the dinner is located (10min drive by car from the pool) at a price of CHF 5 per person (for one or two nights). The hall is open from Friday 22.04.2022 20.00 until Sunday 24.04.2022 09.45. Each Competitor has to bring his own sleeping bag, inflatable mattress etc. The organizers are not liable for lost or stolen items. There is no organised food at the sports hall.
Covid restrictions	Based on the current pandemic situation in Switzerland (December 2021), a <b>valid</b> Covid <b>certificate 2G+</b> (recovered or fully vaccinated (not more than 4 months ago or tested)) is <b>required</b> to participate in the competition. The conditions of admission are checked when entering the swimming pool and anyone who does not have a valid 2G+ certificate will not be admitted (no exceptions will be made - not even for cadre athletes). Based on the pandemic development, we reserve the right to adapt the specifications to the prevailing circumstances
